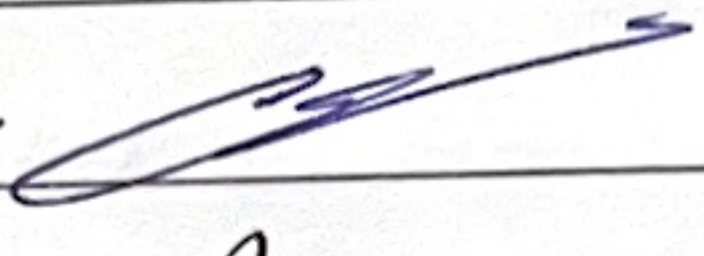
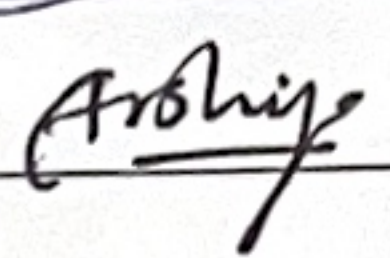
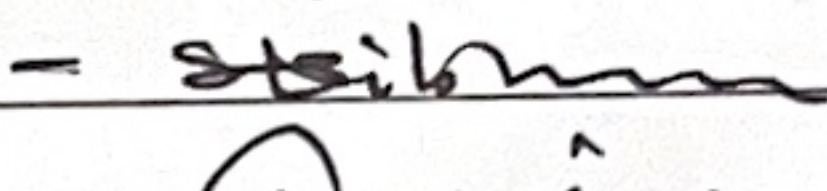
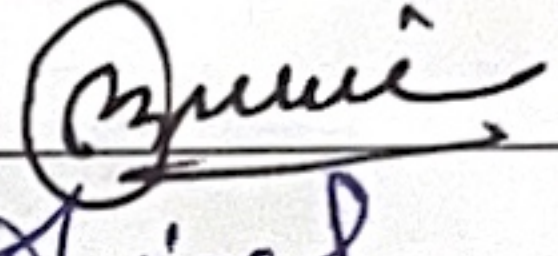
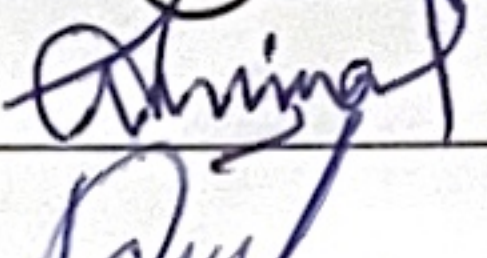
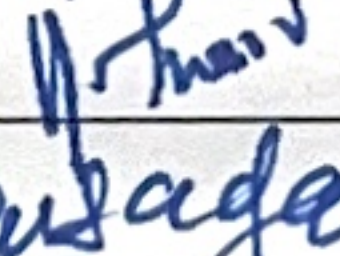
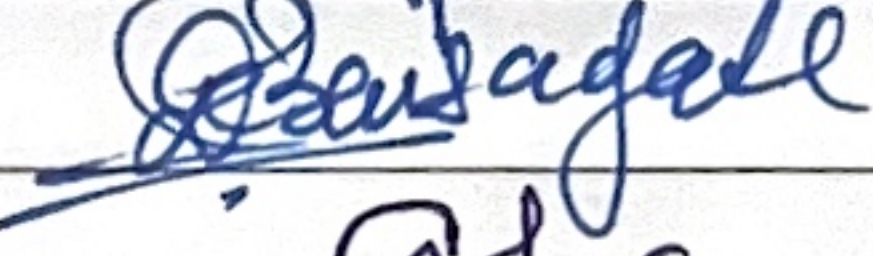


Minutes of the Meeting of 2 May 2025

Agenda 1. To confirm minutes of the previous meeting held on 18th September 2024:

The minutes of the meeting held on 18th September 2024 were read out for confirmation of the members and were confirmed unanimously.

Agenda 2. Review of academic activities during session 2024-25:

Principal Dr. Swati Dharmadhikari presented a detailed review of all the academic activities carried out during the session including examinations. It was also apprised to the members that since the college is now being aided by Department of Higher and Technical Education, a provision is available to appoint teachers on clock-hour basis against the vacancies. The Principal informed that a detailed proposal for the same is submitted to the Joint Director, Nagpur Division for permission.
