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Working President of Yuganton Education Society Mrs. Vanita Tirpude presided over the meeting. The agenda for the meeting was as following:

Agenda 1 :- To confirm minutes of the meeting of 16/10/25.
The Principal read out the minutes of the previous meeting held on 16th Oct. 2025 and were approved.

Agenda 2 :- Information on status of grant under autonomy.
Principal Dr. N. R. Dhurve apprised the members that the University Grants Commission (UGC) shall no longer provide any grant under autonomy as the policy is to provide the same for the initial three sessions after conferment of autonomy. He further informed that the college has already received the grant for the said period, and no further grant is receivable from the UGC.

Agenda 3 :- Information on fee structure for BSW and MSW programmes -

The fee structures for BSW and MSW programmes for the college as approved by the Finance Committee were tabled for approval. After due deliberations on the issue, it was unanimously approved.

Agenda 4 :- Any other matter with permission of the chair.
The Principal tabled in front of members, the External Peer Team Report submitted by the Peer Team for the session

2025-26. Though the team had expressed satisfaction regarding routine affairs of the college, serious concern was raised regarding dearth of full-time faculty and administrative staff. The college being aided by the government cannot recruit fresh staff without permission of govt. authorities. Hence, the working faculty and staff are overburdened. Similarly, due to absence of grant under autonomy, the expenses for examination and routine Statutory Committee meetings are difficult to meet.

The members took serious cognizance of the issue and had discussion on option to withdraw the autonomous status. All the aspects post withdrawal from autonomy were considered in detail. Finally, the Chairman decided to take some time before reaching the decision and instructed the Principal to place the issue in the forthcoming meeting of the Governing Body.

Further, with no matter left for consideration, the meeting concluded with vote of thanks to the Chair and present members by Dr. S.S. Kabiraj.
